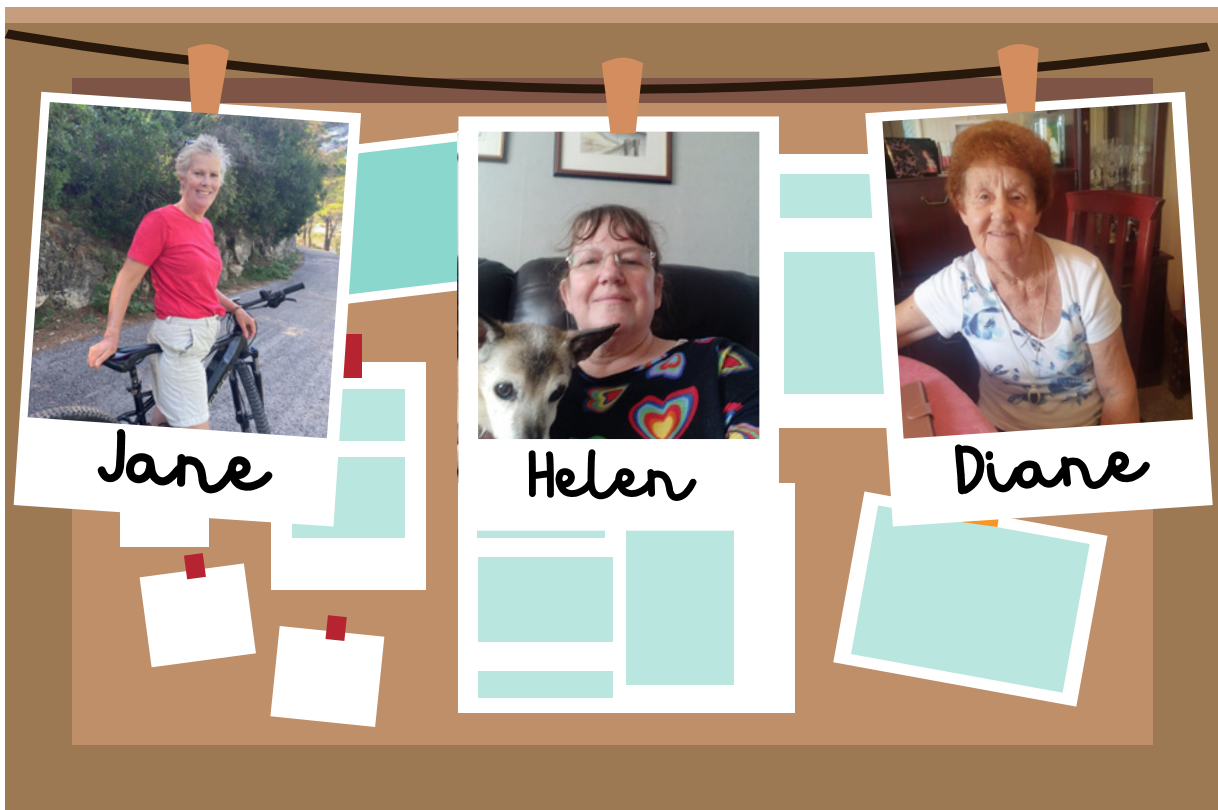

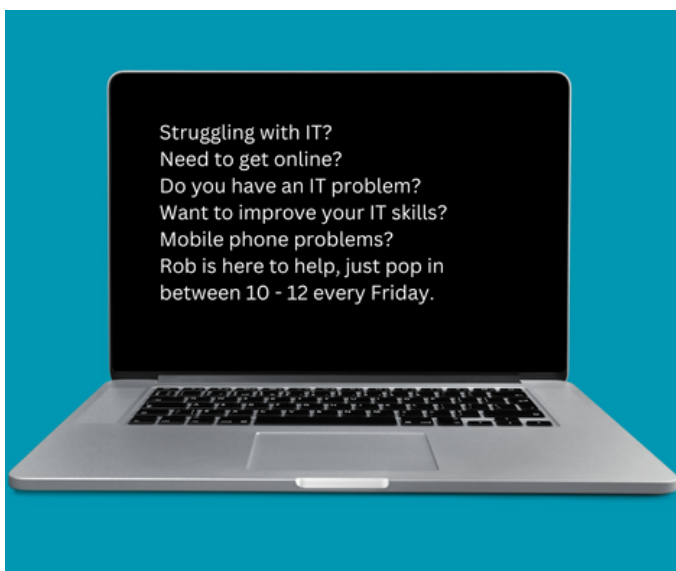

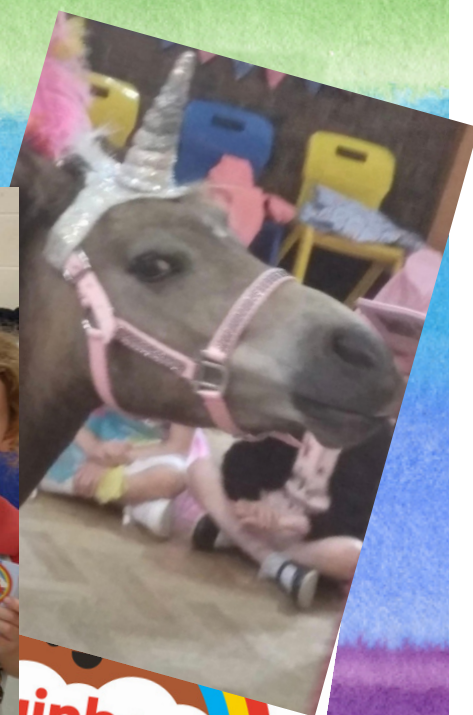


Hello Rainbows
