Helen's Easy Chocolate Cup Cake

You too can make Helen's delicious easy chocolate cup cake as featured on our cover.

Ingredients

40g cocoa powder
3 medium eggs
115g butter
165g soft brown sugar
115g self-raising flour
1teaspoon of baking powder

- 1.Mix the cocoa powder with 7 tablesppons of boiled water and make a paste
- Add all the other ingredients and mix to form a smooth batter.
- 3. Divide equally between 12 cup cake cases.
- 4. Bake for 15-20 mins at 180c
- 5. Decorate when cool with butter icing or melted chocolate
- 6.Enjoy



Did You Know?

Did you know we are currently in the middle of Tourette's Syndrome Awareness Week? Tourette's syndrome is not what many people think it is one of the main myths surounding Tourette's syndrome is that every person with Tourette's syndrome shouts swear words, only around 10% of people with Tourette's syndrome actually have coprolalia, that's the medical term for tics that involve obscenities


There are more of us than you think, Tourette's syndrome affects around 1 in 100 school age children, it starts in childhood and often carries on until adulthood.

The tics, that is the medical name for uncontrolled sudden movements, can be difficult to live with causing embarrassment for some and physical pain and injury for most of us. Most of us with Tourette's syndrome are also diagnosed with co-existing conditions such as OCD, ADHD, Autism, Anxiety for example.

As you can imagine having Tourette's syndrome can be isolating, currently it is very difficult to access the medical care we need which greatly impacts all asspects of our lives from education to relationships and employment.

We have been offering support at the monthly Tourettes Action West Midlands groups here at Stockingford Community Centre. As getting a diagnosis can be a lengthy process which often takes years you don't need a formal diagnosis to come along to meetings and I have found many great, lifelong friends through the Tourette's syndrome community.
